1 Background

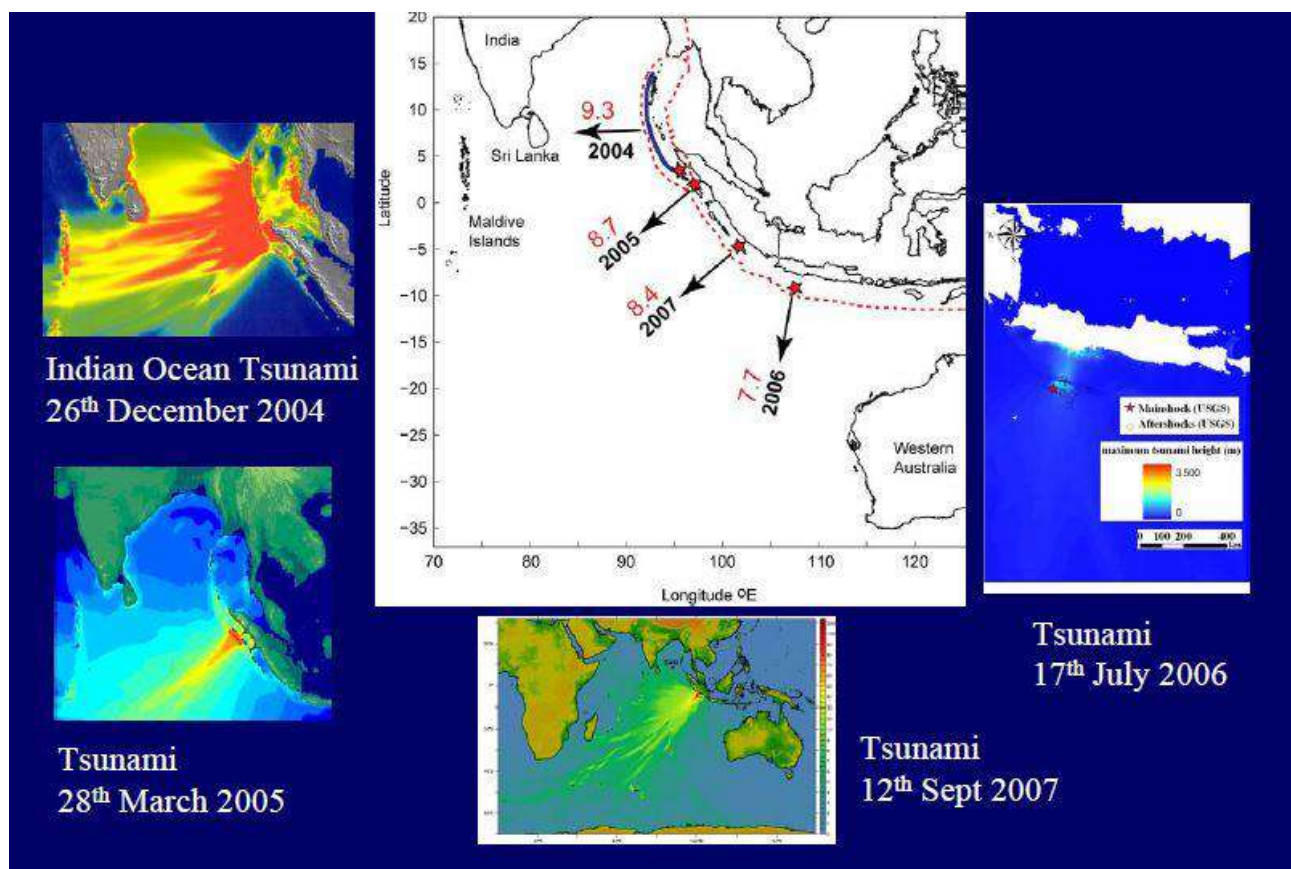
The Tsunami operational plan is the guiding document to manage Tsunami situation of the Colombo district. The Colombo district is prone to experience Tsunami situation and though the Tsunami situation is unable to predict due to insufficient knowledge on patterns or seasons of occurs, it is highly needed to prepare on expected Tsunami situations. Therefore, the District Disaster Management Coordinating Unit (DDMCU) with consultation of the chairman and members of District Disaster Management Committee with divisional secretaries in Tsunami vulnerable divisions has developed this plan with the guidance of Director General, Disaster Management Center of State Ministry of Internal Security, Home Affairs and Disaster Management.

The main objective of this plan is to enhance the preparedness level of the district to response Tsunami effectively to save the lives of the people and reduce the impacts in compare with previous experiences.

2 Past Tsunami experience

On 26 December 2004, Sri Lanka became a victim of the Indian Ocean Tsunami. It caused widespread destruction around the coastal belts of countries close to Indonesia, where the earthquake which triggered the tidal wave took place. In Sri Lanka, more than 35,000 people lost their lives and thousands were left homeless. This disaster brought in its wake, one of the largest humanitarian responses in recent history.

The Tsunamis which occurs in same site, south of Sumatra in 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 are recorded 9.3, 8.7, 7.7, 8.4 magnitudes and it were directed different directions and unable to predict next Tsunami analyzing present data.



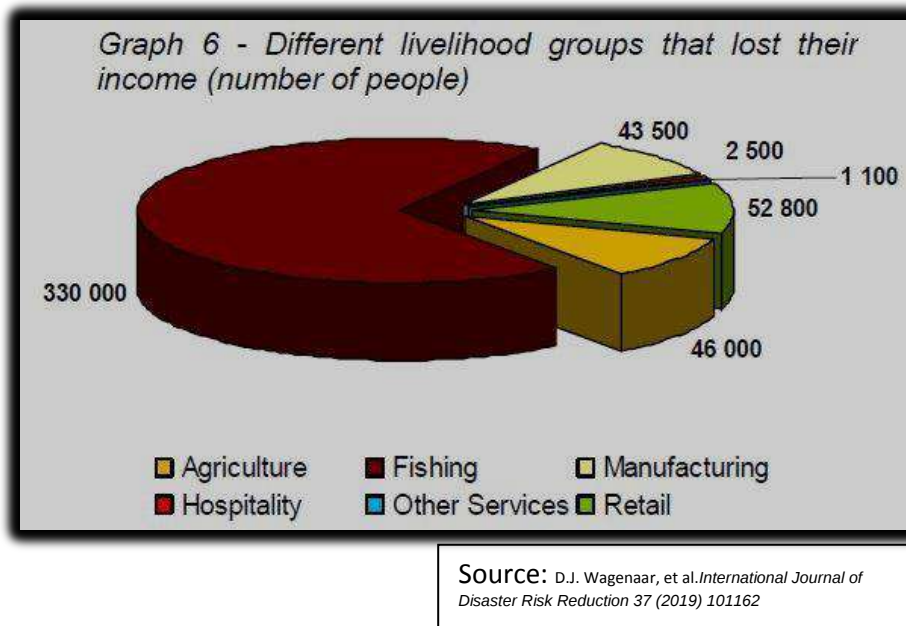

6 EARLY WARNING



Different sensor systems used within the Indian Ocean warning system. All data are transmitted via satellite to the warning center. Besides the early warning system itself, the project also includes capacity building for Sri Lankan institutions, local authorities and the population. These messages are transmitted to the DMC and DDMCU will activate district level Tsunami operational plan accordingly.

The present system of communication from national level to district / divisional / local authority / Grama Niladhari levels or other specific identified locations is mainly through the Police and military communication systems, radio communication, multi-hazard early warning towers, media and the normal telephone systems. Alternative countrywide communication systems already been established and with these improvements, DDMCU ensure that there will be a mechanism to inform the vulnerable communities immediately. These include the Nation-wide Emergency Communication System, which will be used to provide information on

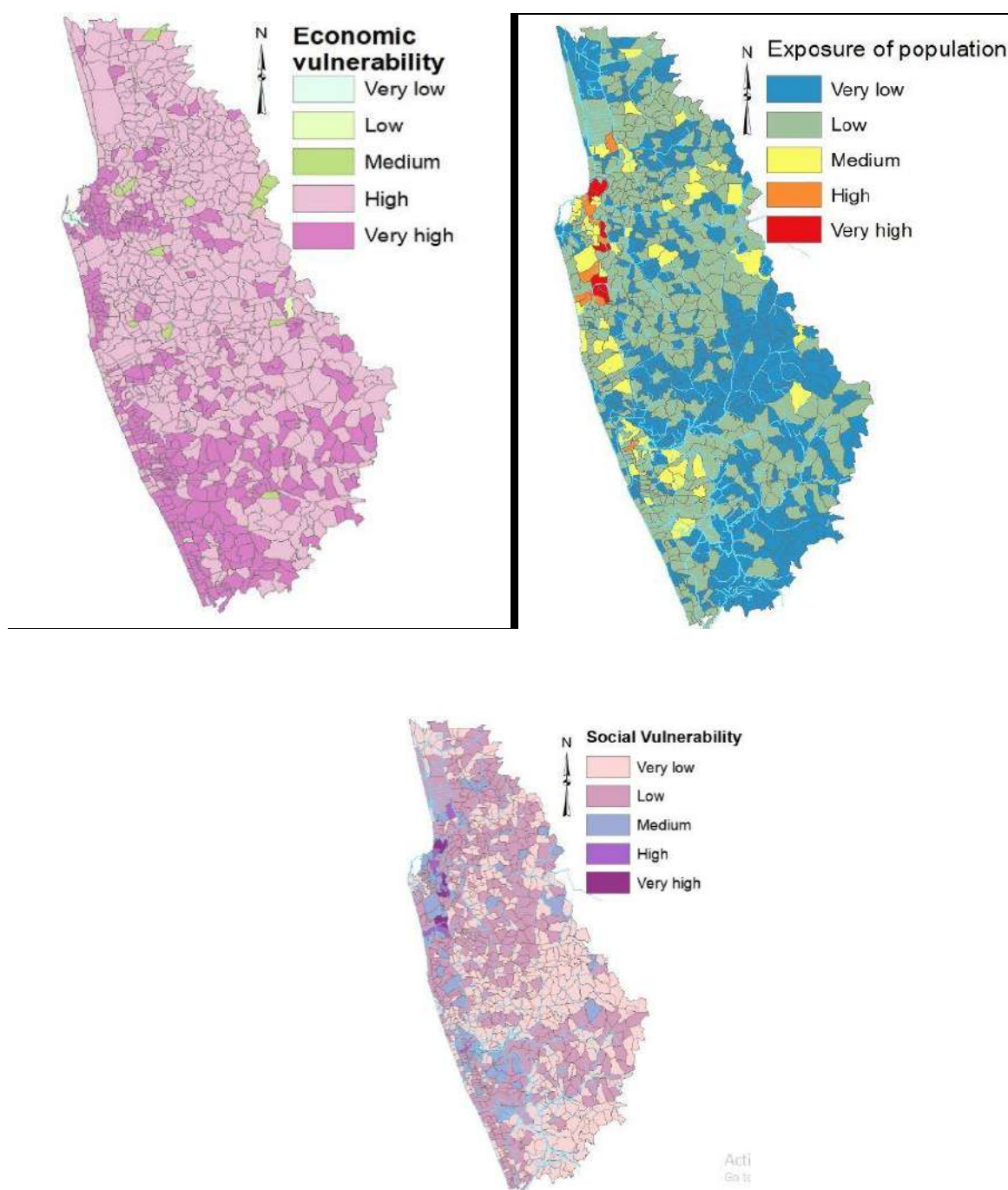

13 Persons at Tsunami Risk –

The risk of tsunami striking a coastline is determined by the probability of having disastrous tsunami waves and the degree of vulnerability (towards life, lifelines, and environment). While even in tsunami-prone regions the risk can be quite small, the vulnerability can nevertheless be extremely huge. Managing this risk puts focus on reducing the vulnerability to a satisfactory extent. Hence the primary objective is to save lives. 14 Vulnerability

In terms of social vulnerability, people are very narrow mind and encouraging the reservation areas for the settlement and living activities. So, most of the settlement areas in coastal line are getting affected from Tsunami. The Divisional Secretaries have identified most vulnerable places with support of DDMCU and GN level officers, but those people are ready to prepare for the Tsunami situation in short notice due to past experience which they had back in 2004. The above vulnerable conditions are making the situation is very critical if it is Tsunami occurs..

15 Governance mechanism

15.1 Local SOP/procedure

The District Secretary is the Incident Commander of the district and all the warnings received by vertical and horizontal will be analysis by DDMCU with advice of Incident Commander and respective technical agencies. After that, the early warning message will be disseminated to the last mile through respective Divisional Secretaries and district level stakeholders.

The DDMCU Colombo has whats app groups with key contact persons and all the early warning message will be sent to take necessary action. Further, the information will be shared to the key contacts over the phone to alert the stakeholders.

All the early warnings will be shared with the media unit of District Secretariat, Colombo to provide and coordinate the district and national level media.

Dissemination of early warning at community level will be handled by respective Divisional Secretaries through GN level staff and in case of emergency the Divisional Secretaries will be used public announcing system and other resources available at GN Divisions such as temple, church, mosque and CBOs.

Further, all the responsibilities have distributed to stake holders as their own responsibilities and let them to activate their own SOPs accordingly.

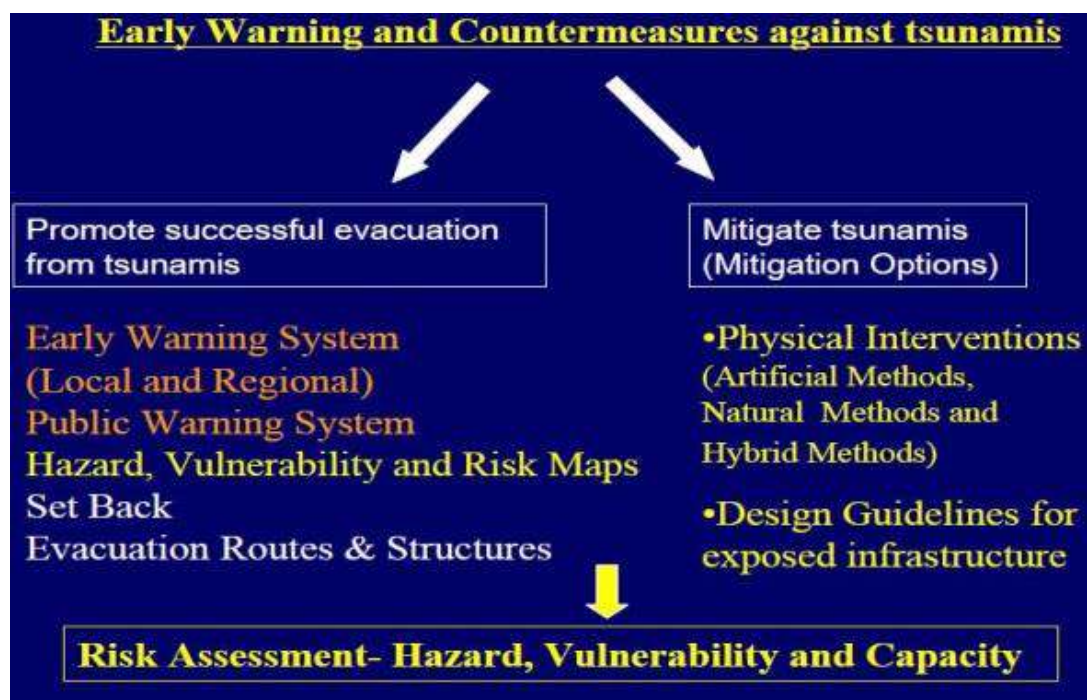

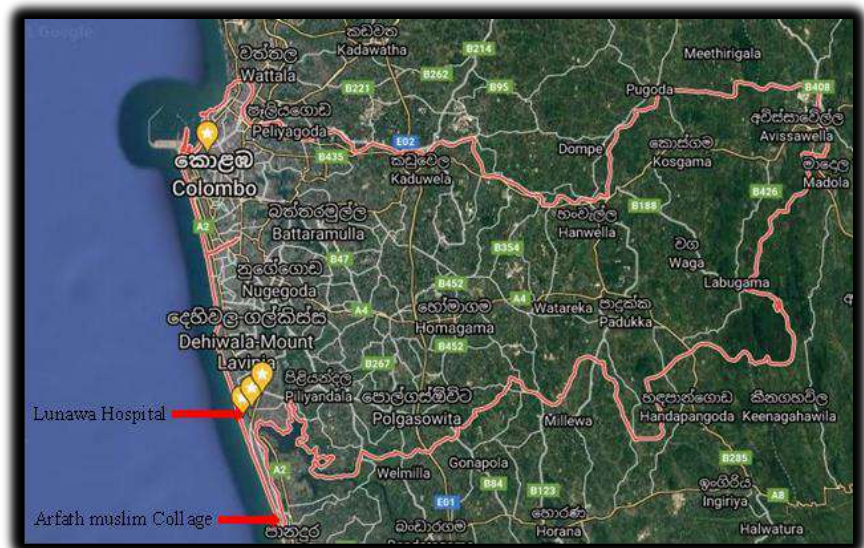

22 Tsunami early warning towers in Colombo district

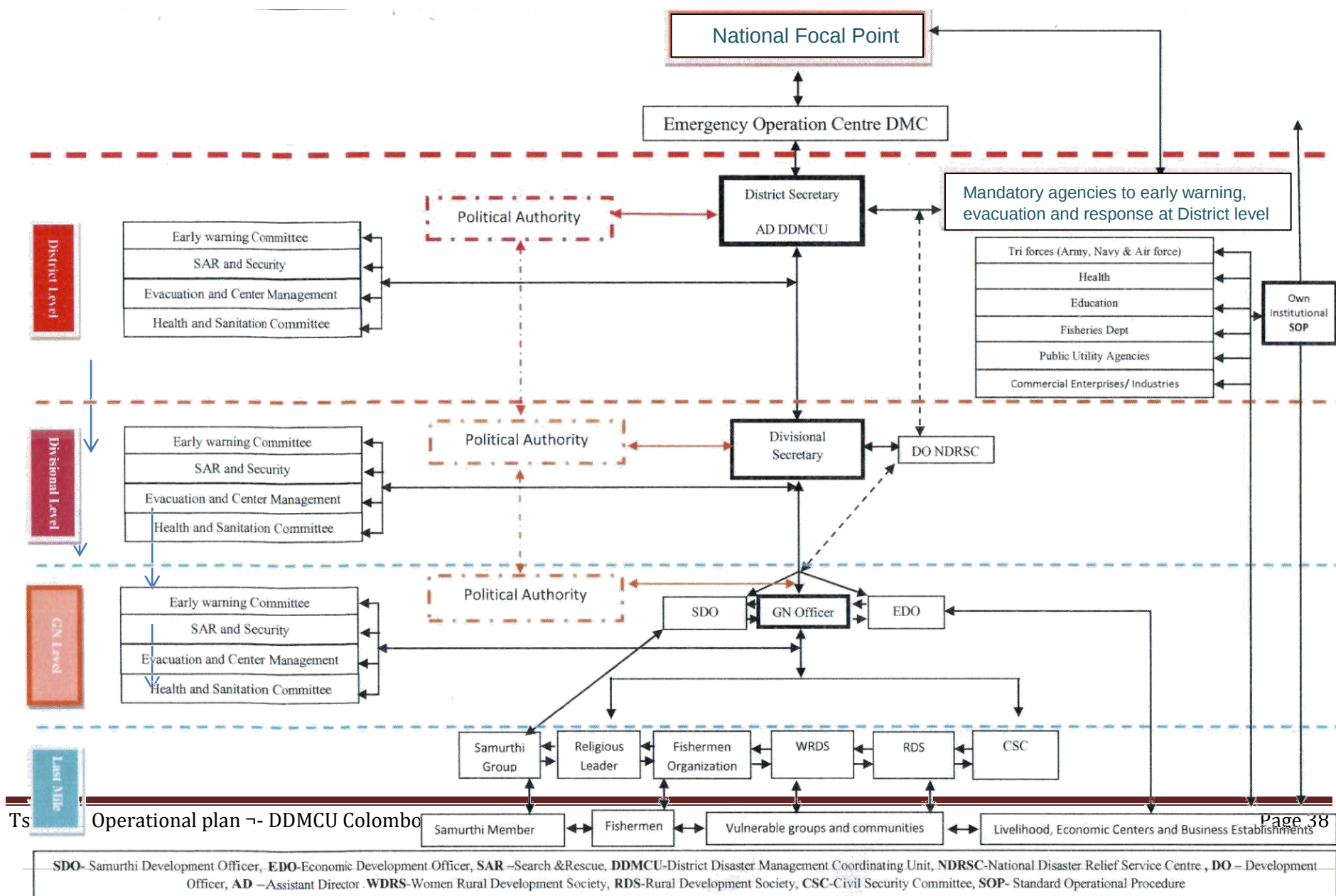

23.1 Activation of Institutional Response Plans

All institutes are act according to their institutional DM plans and some of the institutes which are in elevated buildings also selected as immediate evacuation points, if there is not sufficient time to withdraw to assign safety locations. The institute should have an organized mechanism in their institute itself and they may assign tasks according to their seniorities. Further, they should maintain incident command system within the organization and it should in line with divisional DM plans

23.2 Protections of vulnerable people, children and properties

The protection of vulnerable people, children and properties are ensured through GN level disaster management links and they are already being recorded in divisional secretariats and will be facilitated as required by DS level officials. The required assistants will be provided by NDRSC officer in relevant DS coordinating with social service department.

23.3 Activation of transportation plan for timely evacuation

Activation of transportation plan will be done by DS level disaster management committee with assistants of SLTB, Central Transport authority, Private bus organizations, Other government agencies etc. The require information will be provided by DDMCU, Divisional sec or responsible authority.

23.4 Activate mobility plan (the city emergency traffic management plan)

All the mobility plan is totally look after by Sri Lanka Police department and Police has separate plan for activate, if the coastal line transportation blocked. Hence, according to the situations arises Police will decide the plan and will be implemented.

23.5 Ensure the safety of the livelihood activities (Fishing gears, Poultry farm, etc.)

The safety of the fishing gears, boats related to fishing will be secured by fishing organizations and they will be informed by DDMCU, Police or other early warning agencies. The plan is included to respective DS level plans.

23.6 Ensure the safety of animal and pets

The safety of animals and pets will be looked after by owners of the pets and DS level veterinary support will be provided as required.

23.7 Evacuation plan for persons with disability, pregnancy, feeding mothers, etc.

Evacuate all potentially affected population in time towards safe grounds is mandatory, so that persons will not be impacted by the waves or by floating debris. Usually, in rather populated areas, detailed planning is necessary in order to make evacuation as efficient as possible; hence an evacuation plan has to be set up, implemented, monitored, maintained and constantly updated by

local decision makers. The people with disability are known by divisional secretariat and they will be provided assistant by respective divisional secretariat according to divisional DM plans with assistant of identified neighbours. The details of pregnant women and feeding mothers are available with respective MOH offices and they will provide assistants as required according to respective DM plans.

23.8 Evacuation of the area

If there is a threat, the DDMCU will order for evacuation. Then the message will be passed through above early warning dissemination mechanism to evacuate the people to the safer areas. During the evacuation the following duties want to carry us by the relevant stakeholders.

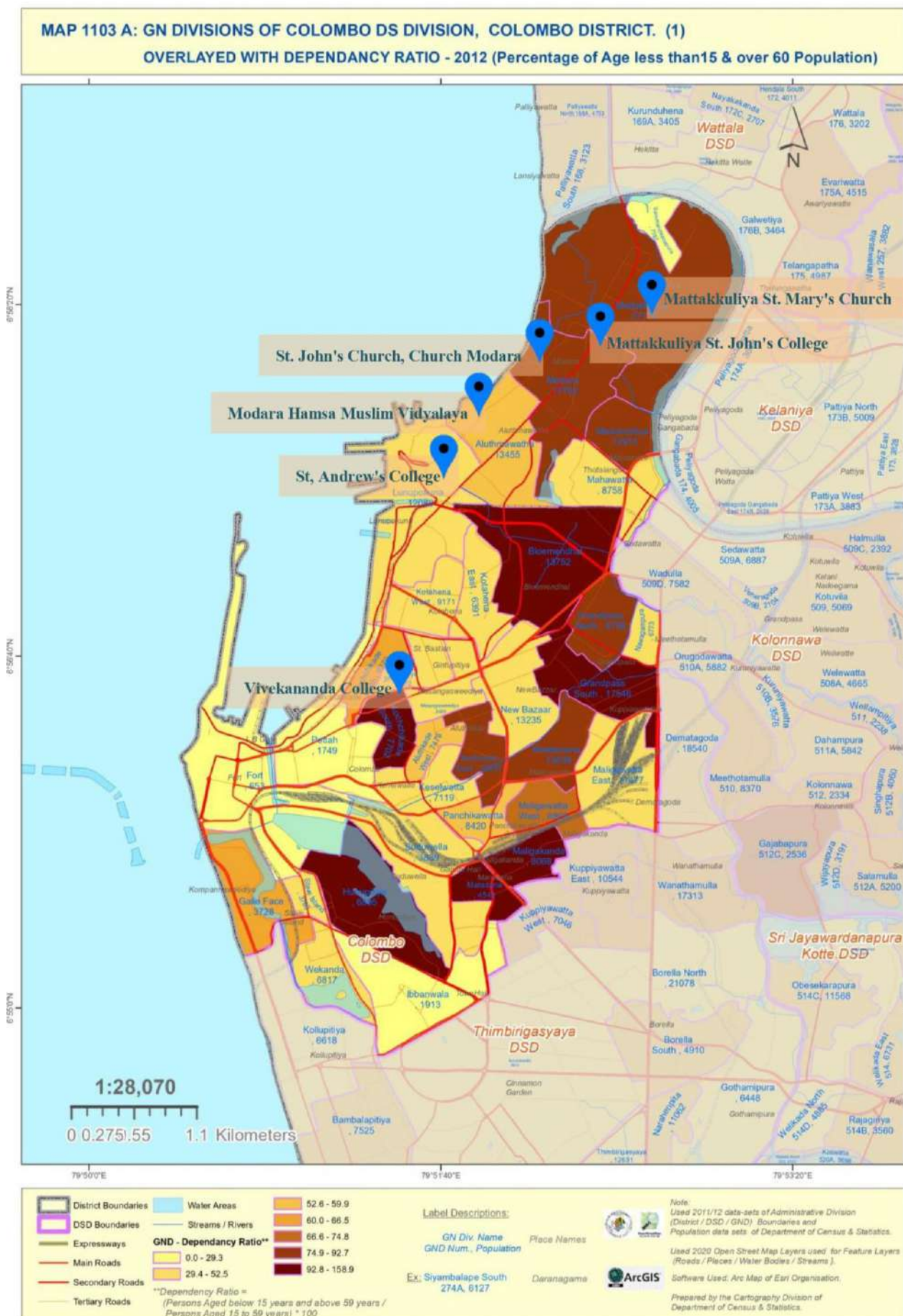

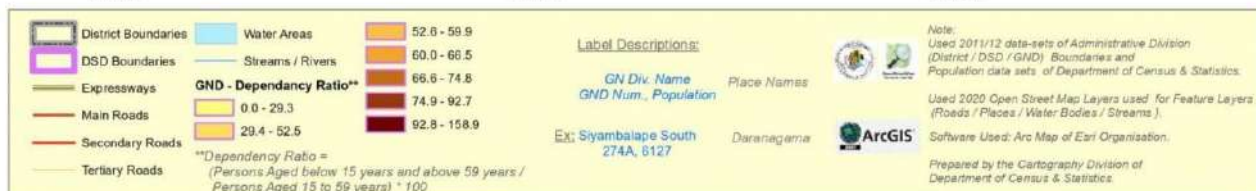
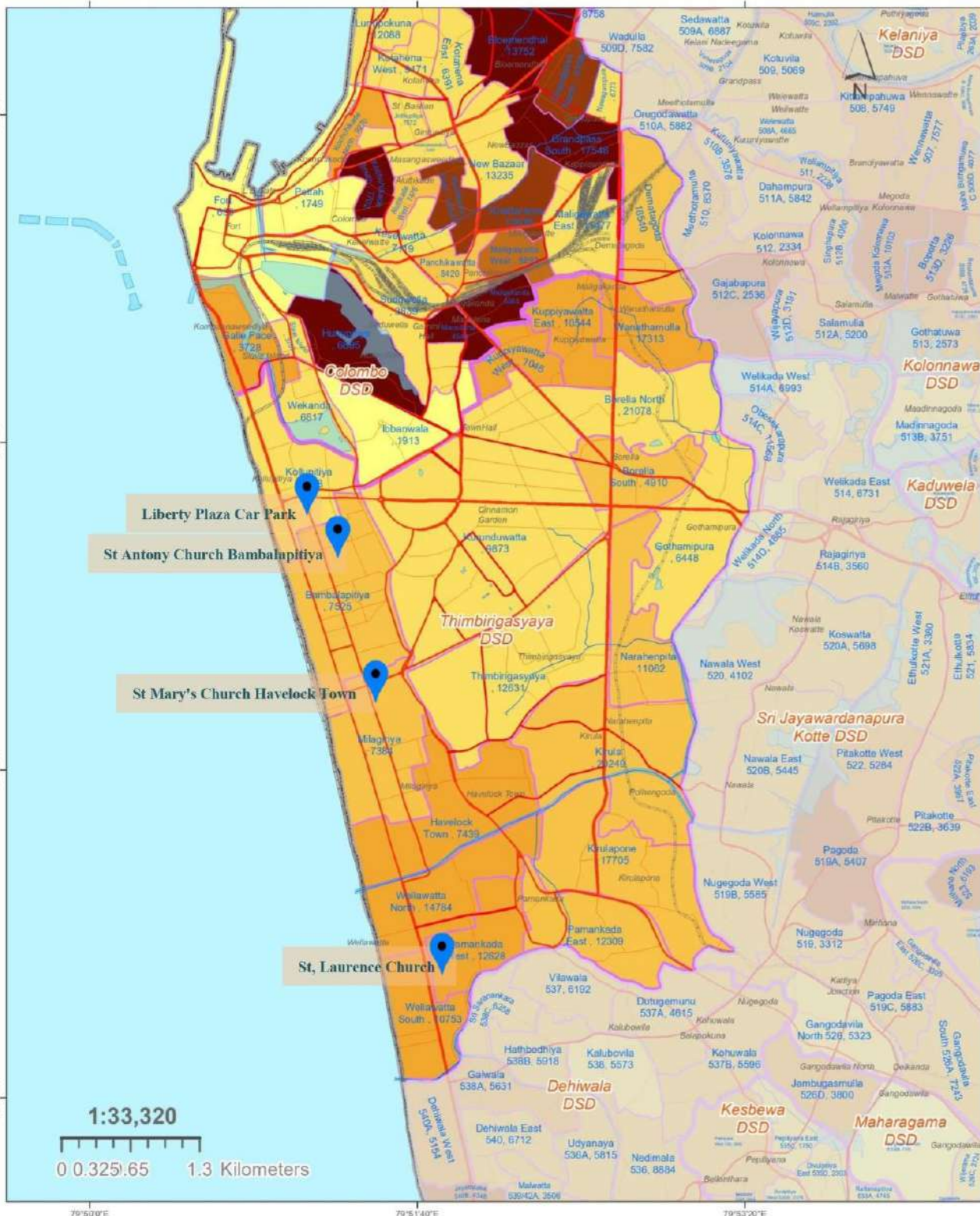

MAP 1127 A: GN DIVISIONS OF THIMBIRIGASYAYA DS DIVISION, COLOMBO DISTRICT. (9)

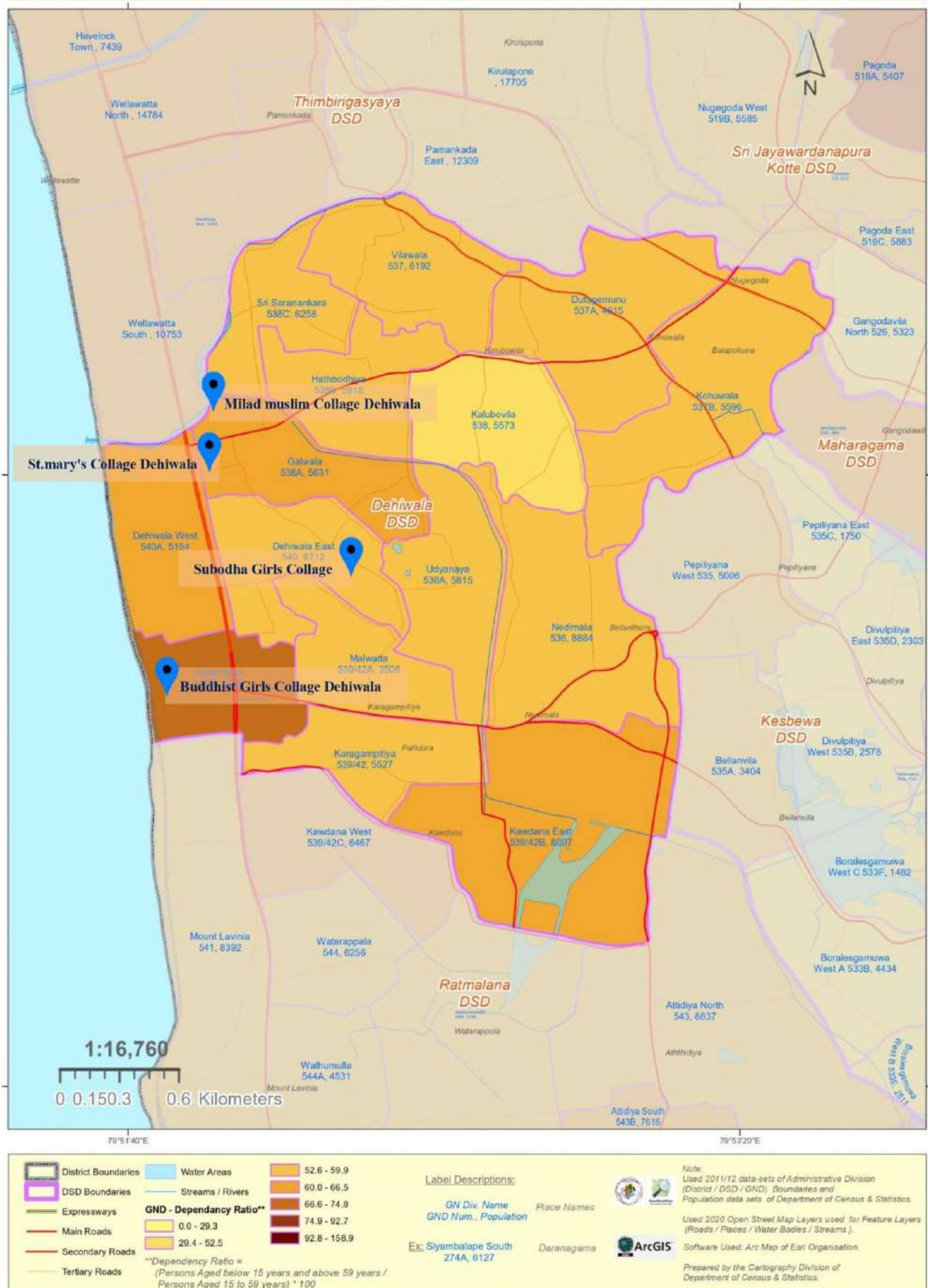

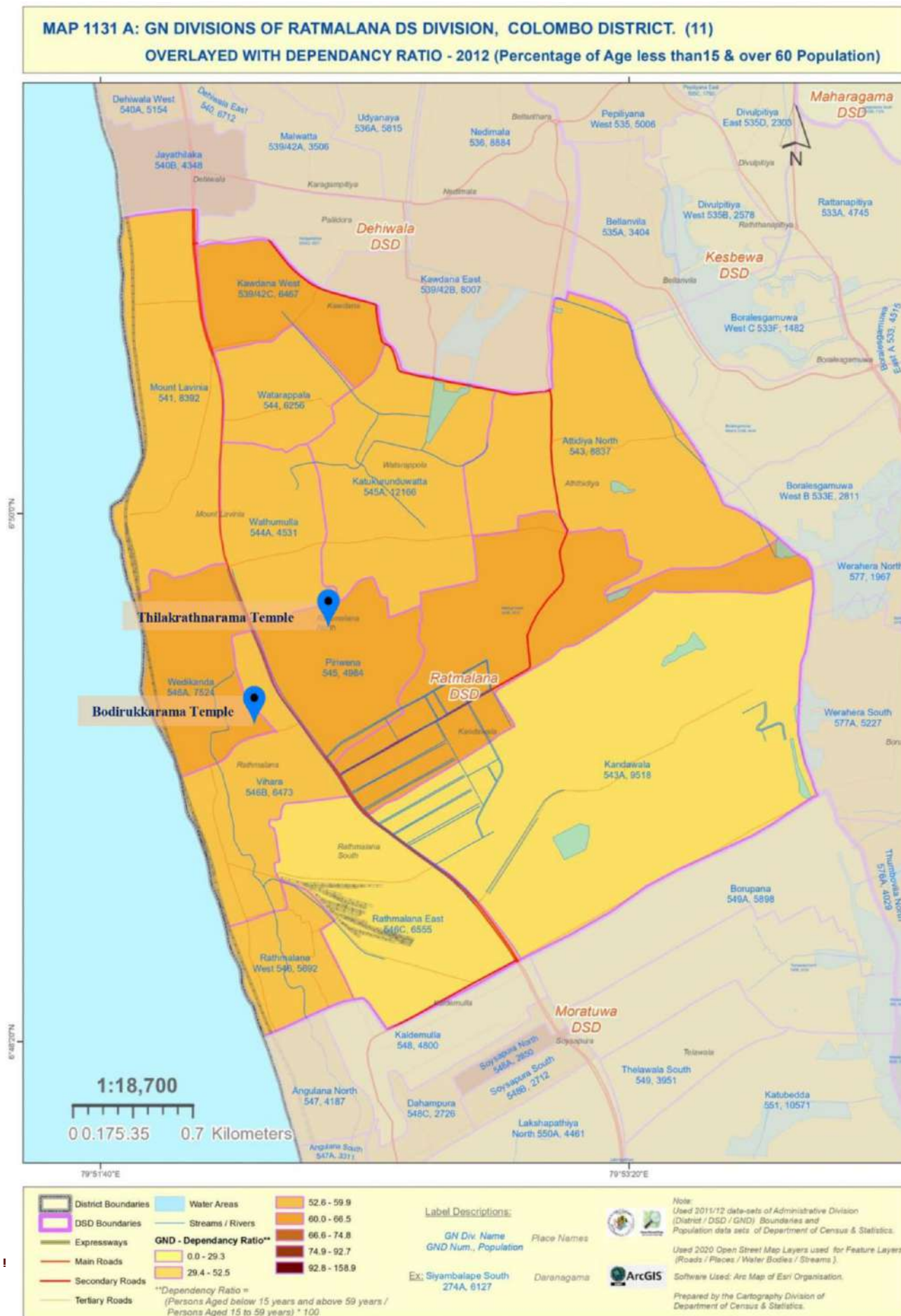

OVERLAYED WITH DEPENDANCY RATIO - 2012 (Percentage of Age less than 15 & over 60 Population)



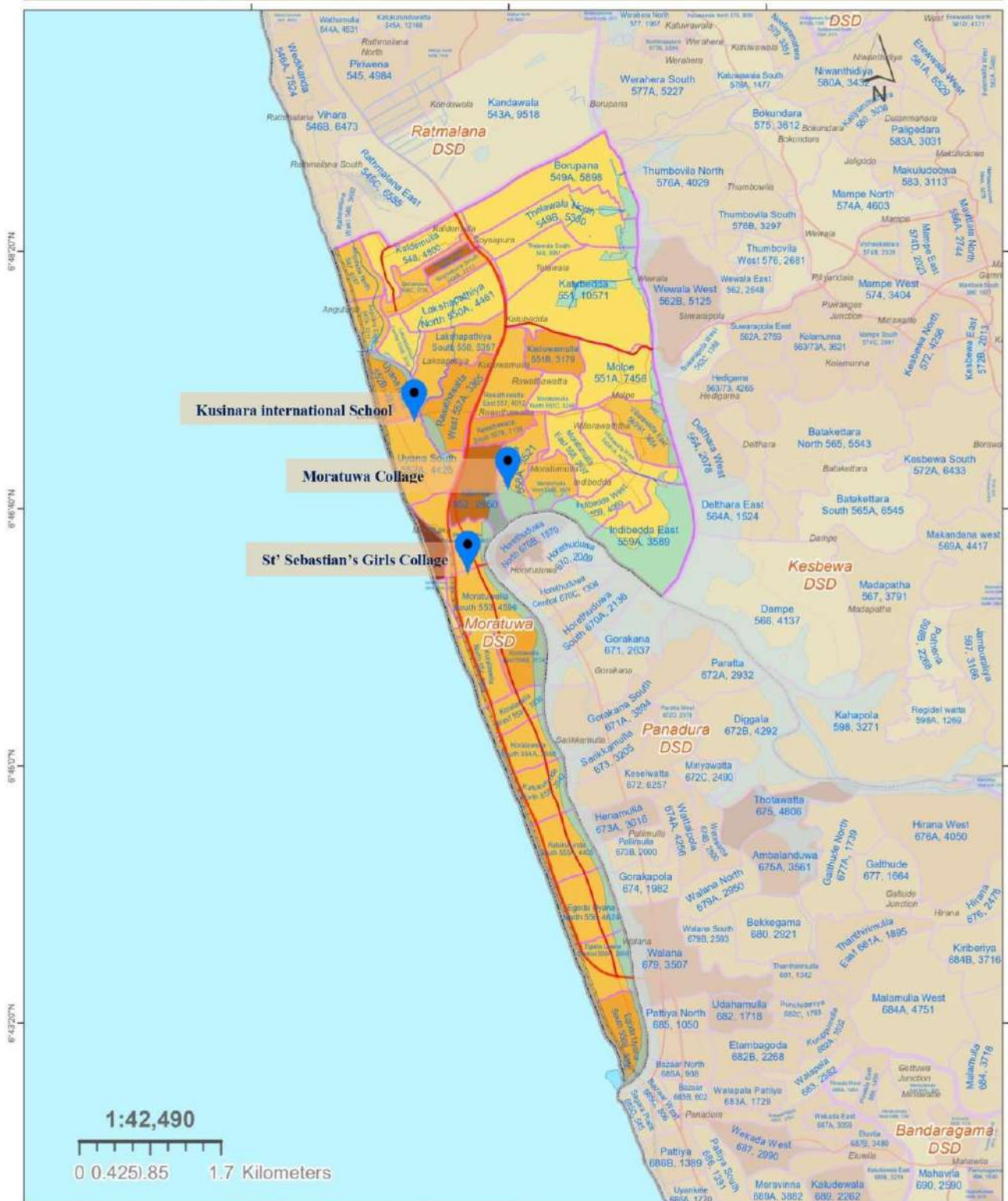

Deployment of first aid teams is mandatory in immediate effect for minimize life loses and the Health department, volunteers, NGOs are assigned to attend such cases when arises.

31.2 Evacuation (Include “COVID 19” preparedness guideline)

Present day context, Covid 19 epidemic is an issue and it will be more challengeable for evacuation process considering safety of officials and victims both. Hence, entire evacuation process will be guided by Covid 19 preparedness guidelines and relevant SOPs will be promulgated by each and every stake holders and will be in line with national, district, DS level plans.

31.3 Immediate relief (Need basis)

Immediate relief will done by Sri Lanka Forces, SL Police and later relief operation will be handled by divisional secretariats with NDRSC officers with support of NGOs, donors etc.

32 RELIEF COODINATION-

33 Disaster Relief and Emergency Relief Coordination

The disaster relief activities will be managed by district operational manager. The Addl. Government Agent (Admin) was assigned to the district relief management with the involvement of the DDMCU and DMC. The Development officer (NDRSC) will assist him/her to facilitate the relief activities.

The Divisional level relief activities will be coordinated by Divisional Secretaries through Divisional NDRSC officer and Grama Niladharies as per the relief circulars.

33.1 Camp management with the Sphere standard

Camp management will be handled under supervision of respective divisional secretaries and NDRSC officer. The division secretary will be the incident commander and will be activated incident command system accordingly. Further they will act roles as mentioned respective divisional disaster management plans, GN plans. The safety centers will be the camps and NGOs, other government agencies will attend to provide cooked foods from the selected suppliers which mentioned in DS level management plans.

33.2 WASH (water and Sanitation) Establish medical facilities

Water and sanitization will be handled by National water board and ministry of health. Individual hospitals and national water board are having separate disaster response plans to cater such disasters and all the activities which those institutes are implemented are in line with national disaster management plan.

34 Emergency Relief coordination and distribution (Non food for all and special needs people)

As per the divisional DM plans, NGOs, donors and government relief mechanism will be activated simultaneously and provide food, nonfood item as required and details of special need people, and other are with respective divisional secretariats and will be activated according to DM plan.

PHASE 5:

35 EARLY RECOVERY –

Early recovery response plan

The Director Planning of the District assist to Government agent for the early recovery of the areas through the District and Divisional planning department. Further, DDMCU has bond relations with NGOs and these organizations may help people to recover as required.

36 Capacity of the areas

The District Disaster Management Committee is in active and implementing several activities with advice of Incident Commander (District Secretary). The DDMCU is playing a major role to coordinate all the departments and resources for an effective preparedness and response. Technical Departments such as Irrigation, Metrology, RDA, SLLDC are closely working with DDMCU as well the government also extending its support. The GN division level responses are managed by GN level staff such as GN, Development Officer and Samurdhi Development Officer with guidance and support of Divisional Disaster Management Committee under the chair of Divisional Incident Commander (Divisional Secretary).

Tri-forces are the back born of the District Disaster Management Committee for the emergency response and always support for the preparedness, early warning and search & rescue operation. The DDMCU have good coordination with tri-forces to coordinate district level disaster management activities. Police also plays major role to management disaster situation and, they are supporting to disseminate the early warning, search & rescue, welfare center safety and traffic management, etc.

Apart from this, all the district level stakeholders are well aware about the flood risk of the district and implementing several activities through their annual plan to minimize the impact of disasters.

Further, DDMCU has located dinghy boats with engines in highly vulnerable areas and there is possibility to hire such boats from fishing community in district due to huge numbers of people are using engine boats for their daily fishing activities.

36.1 Restoration of the communication

The restoration of communication will be done by respective communication companies under supervision of ministry of communication and mass media. Till the communication restores, manual communication system will be implemented such as hailer system, television, etc.

36.2 Dead body and mass causality handling

The hospital staff under supervision of ministry of health will be mainly engaged for death body management and considering the volume of the disaster impact, tri forces will be engaged accordingly.

36.3 Clearing debris

The cleaning up the sites and removing debris will be done by tri forces and volunteers if respective municipal council would not be able to handle due to the impact of tsunami.
